Colossians 1:24-2:5**

What is the profile of a disciple-maker?

Disciple-makers are Christ-empowered, catalytic servant-leaders who use their influence to multiply Christ-like influencers.

- I. Their character: Christ empowered Col. 1:24-25
 - a. Christlikeness: joy in affliction- filling up what is lacking of the sufferings of Christ- love for God's people.
 - b. Two images: a minister and a steward.

- II. Their competencies: catalytic servant leaders Col. 1:25-28.
 - a. Their message: the word of God, the mystery hidden, the riches of glory, Christ in you- the hope of glory, Him we proclaim! vs. 25-28.
 - b. Their methods: God's words demonstrated in good works.

- III. Their objective: to use their influence to multiply Christ-like influencers Col 1:28-2:5
 - a. To present everyone mature in Christ.
 - b. To protect everyone from competing worldviews.
