- **I.** Putting to death worldly lifestyles Colossians 3:5-10.
 - a. In their personal lives: sexual immorality (sexual practices outside of marriage), impurity (moral corruption), passion (debilitating desire), evil desire (lustful craving), idolatrous covetousness.
 - b. In their Interpersonal communication: anger, wrath, malice, slander (blasphemy), obscene talk, lies.
- **II.** Putting on their new humanity Colossians 3:11-17.
 - Transcends race and ethnicity (Jew-Greek), religion (circumcised-uncircumcised), culture (barbarian), social status (slave-free)-Christ all in all.
 - b. In their personal lives: God's chosen ones, holy, beloved The lifestyle of love and peace.
 - c. In their interpersonal communication: God's Word and our works.
