Turning Points- The ultimate questions 1 Peter 2:1-12

Are you willing to stop flirting with Jesus Christ?

Ultimate commitment to Jesus Christ demands that his followers...

- I. Refine their taste to feed on God's provision: Believers 1 Peter 2:1-3.
 - a. Putting away malice, deceit, hypocrisy, envy, slander...
 - b. Born again to mature in salvation by feeding on God through his word (cf. Psalm 34:8, Heb. 5:11-6:3, Lucas 8:19-21).
- II. Rebuild their lives on Jesus Christ in spite of the world's rejection: Disciples 1 Peter 2:4-8 (cf. Psalm 118:22, Mark 12:1-12, Is. 28:16, Juan 15:18-20).
- III. Redefine their purpose to join Christ in his mission: disciple-makers 1 Peter 2:9-12.
 - a. Who am I? Where do I come from? What is my purpose? vs. 9-10.
 - b. How then should we live? vs. 11-12.

True disciple-makers are Saved, Sanctified, and Sent To believe, live, and give God's saving Word
