 - b. Living Christ's new commandment: From darkness to light, from hate to love, no stumbling to anyone unity cf. Romans 16:17-20, 1 John 3:14-18,23, John 17:20-23.
- II. The opportunities to help every follower of Jesus grow in maturity to reach the fullness of their God-given potential: children, young men, fathers 1 John 2:12-14, Ephesians 4:11-16- Ready for more update.
