 - a. Is Jesus enough to secure our eternal destiny? The question of faith.
 - b. Is Jesus enough to transform our brokenness? The question of hope.
 - c. Is Jesus enough to satisfy our deepest longings? The question of love.
- II. Demonstrating the power of God's love to turn hate-filled sinners into loving, sacrificial, generous, satisfied, Spirit-filled members of God's family: Our cup spills over 1 John 3:11-24.
 - a. Do you know what love is? 1 John 3:16.
 - b. Do you know what love is for?

But out of the fullness of a God-satisfied heart.
