 - a. The thief: Who is pulling the strings? the flesh, the world and the devil (cf. Eph. 2:1-3).
 - b. The thief strategy: steal, kill, destroy cf. Mark 5:1-17.
- II. What he is willing and able to do for those who call on his name John 10:10
 - a. The good shepherd and the door: Direction, protection, freedom Jn 10:9-10.
 - b. His strategy: the giving of his life so that we may live 10:11.
