We faithfully witness our hope in Jesus when...

- 1. We truly believe He's granted us forgiveness "once and for all" (10:11-18)
 - A. Before: Yearly reminder of our sins (10:3-4)
 - B. Jesus: Has perfected those who are being sanctified (10:14)
 - C. Now: God remembers our sins no more (10:17 & Jeremiah 31:34 & Romans 8:1-2)
- 2. Approach God with confidence for He is Faithful (10:19-23)
 - A. Before: High Priest & Holy Places (Hebrews 8-9)
 - B. Jesus: The New and Living Way (10:19-21)
 - C. Now: Guiltless and Purified by His Blood (10:22-23 & 1 Corinthians 1:9)
- 3. We encourage one another (10:24-25)
 - A. Before: Loneliness, guilt, and shame (Genesis 3:8-9)
 - B. Jesus: The community of the Body (10:24)
 - C. Now: Encouragement and Healing (10:25 & James 5:16)

When we truly live according to the Gospel of Jesus Christ He turns our lives into instruments of transformation, showing the world what true hope looks like.

Let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, preparing for the more our Lord has in store for us in 2025.
