 - a. The enemy's plan v. 4, 9, John 10:10.
 - b. Yahweh's intervention 6-10, 1 Jn 3:8, Heb. 2:114-18, Col 2:13-15.

- II. His matchless character as the inexhaustible inspiration for their praise: Song -holy, strong, merciful Ex 15:11-13.**

- III. His steadfast, gracious, covenant keeping, redeeming love: Salvation 15:2, 13-18 (Revelation 15:1-14).**
