The church remains faithful to its God-given calling by standing firmly on God's truth, appointing qualified leaders, and protecting sound doctrine. Once that foundation is laid, how can we remain healthy and continue advancing God's mission for generations to come?

The Church faithfully advances God's mission when...

- I. Every generation is intentionally disciplined (2:1–10).
 - a. The Experienced, the young, all of us (1-9) (1 Timothy 2:3-6)
 - b. Adorning the doctrine of God our Savior (10)
- II. Every disciple is transformed by grace (2:11–15).
 - a. Justification: The grace that saves (11)
 - b. Sanctification: The grace that transforms (12)
 - c. Glorification: The anticipation of what is to come (13-15)
- III. Every disciple leads by example (3:1–15).
 - a. Show good testimony (1, 2)
 - b. Remember your own walk (3-8)
 - c. Protect the church's unity for the sake of its witness: The “Matthew 18 Method” (9-15)
